

Star Night

This is a small design using some stitches over two squares to create the star. Back stitches are used so count the stitches carefully.

Beads can be added for extra texture and sparkle.

Mill Hill Glass Beads 2011 Victorian Gold or,
Mill Hill Glass Beads 666 Christmas Red

Materials:

14 count Aida. 7 x 7 inches

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton
310 Black, one skein
666 Christmas red - bright, one skein

Tapestry needle No. 24

Beading needle

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards. Use one strand of cotton for the back stitch and two strands for the cross stitch. Attach the beads after the embroidery has been completed
