Beads:

 MHG-2011 Mill Hill Glass Beads-Victorian Gold

Create your own stained glass window with these mini motifs in Christmas colours. Use them for gift tags or as a simple sampler. Metallic gold thread can be used in place of DMC 680 Old gold to add lustre.

Material:

28 count evenweave or 14 count Aida, 7 x 7 inches

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton:
310 Black, one skein
498 Christmas red, one skein
500 Blue-green, one skein
680 Old gold, one skein
796 Royal blue, one skein

Mill Hill glass beads 2011 Victorian gold, one packet

Tapestry needle No.24

Beading needle

Stitches used:

Back stitch
Cross stitch

Method:

Work from the centre of the design outwards using TWO strands of cotton for the cross stitch and ONE strand for the back stitch. Where possible work the back stitch after the cross stitch has been worked to create a neater finish.
Add the beads after the embroidery has been stitched.
