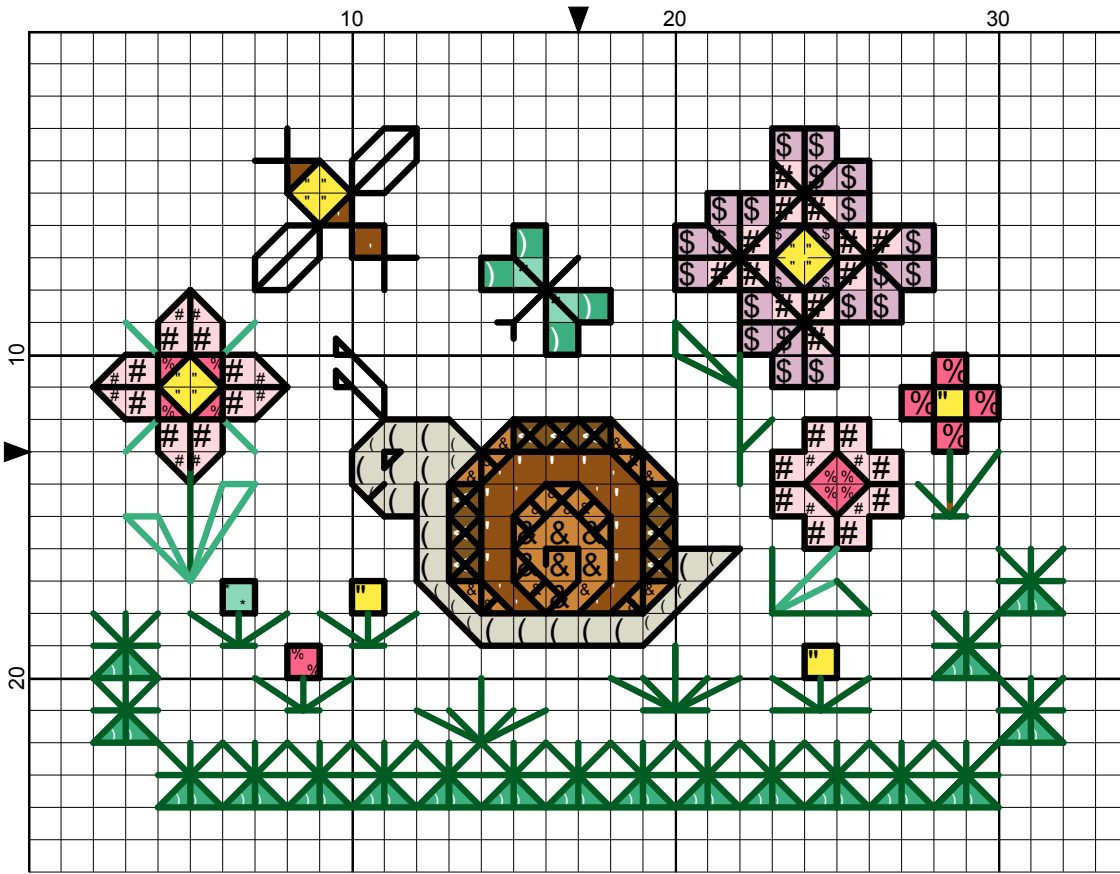

It is very useful for using up all those scraps of thread which might be needed one day.

## Materials:

14 count Aida 6 x 5 inches

## Threads:

For Blackwork Snail:  
DMC Stranded cotton 310 Black

For Coloured Snail:  
Use oddments of thread or,

DMC Stranded cotton  
310 Black  
367 Lemon  
433 Brown - medium  
554 Violet - light  
699 Christmas green  
943 Aquamarine - medium  
956 Geranium  
959 Seagreen - medium  
963 Dusky rose - ultra very light  
975 Golden brown - light  
976 Golden brown - medium  
3024 Brown grey - ultra light

Tapestry needle No.24

## Stitches used:

Back stitch  
Cross stitch

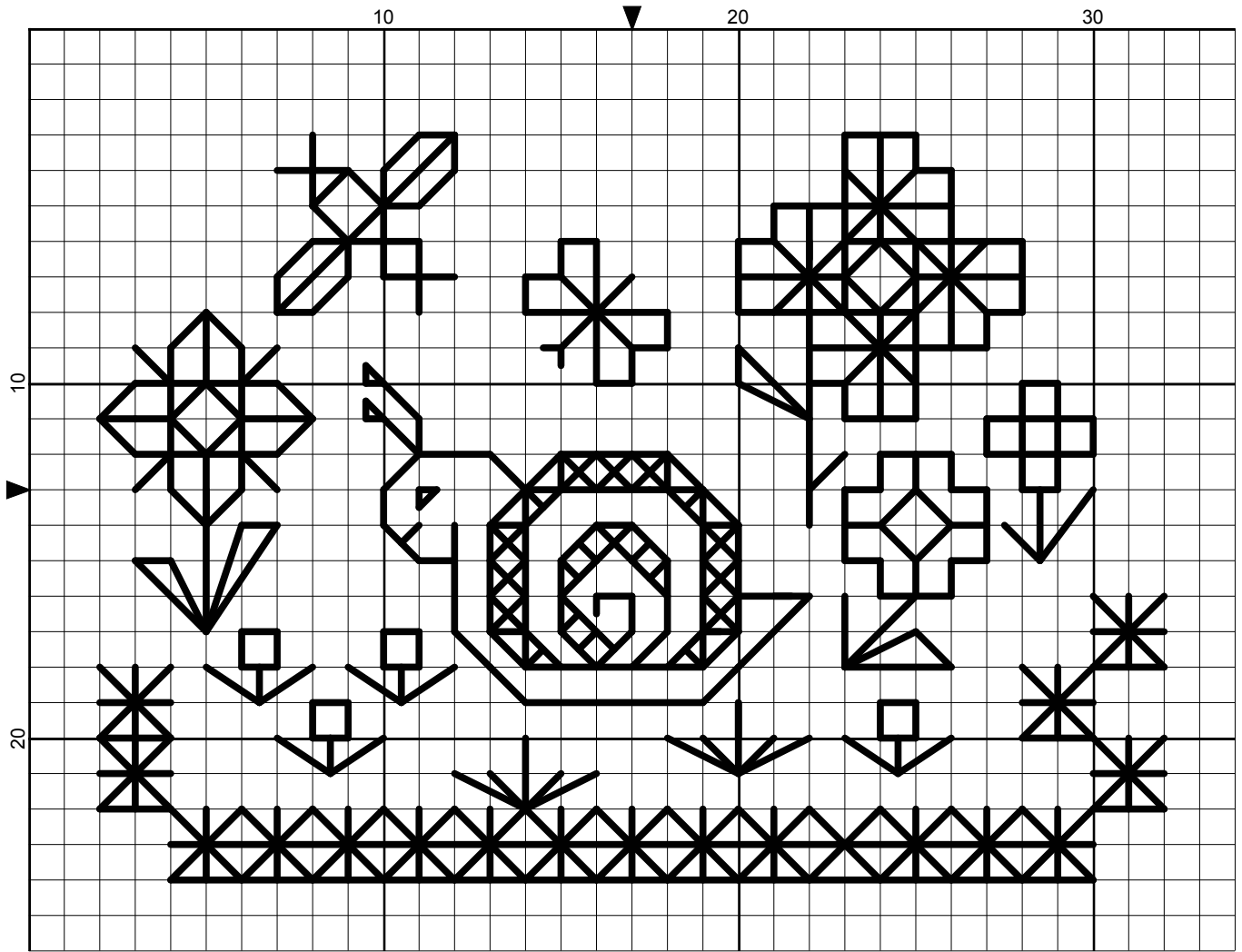
## Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards. Use two strands of cotton for the cross stitch and one strand for the back stitch.
