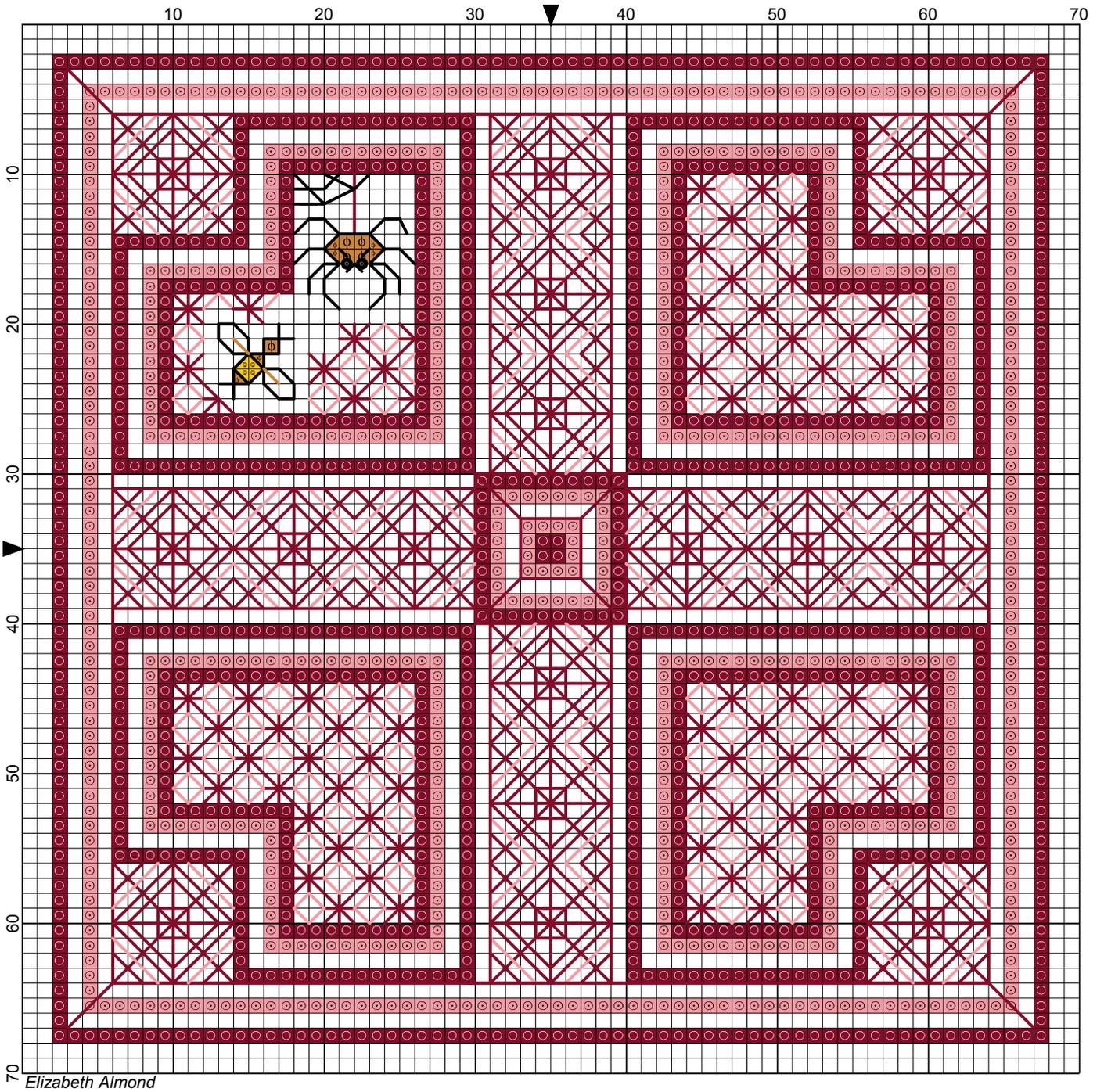

Cobweb

"Welcome to my cobweb!" said the spider to the fly.

A repeat design using cross stitch and blackwork to create a lacy effect. The spider is optional. If he doesn't belong in your embroidery just repeat the motif from the other sections. Use a different combination of colours to create a different style.

Materials:

14 count Aida, 7 x 7 inches, or
28 count evenweave

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton
310 Black, 12 inches
444 Lemon - dk, 12 inches
976 Golden brown - medium, 12 inches
776 Pink - medium, one skein
777 Raspberry - vy dk, one skein.

Tapestry needle No.24

Stitches used:

Back stitch
Cross stitch
Half cross stitch (spider and bee)
French knot (spider's eyes)

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards. Use ONE strand for the back stitch and TWO strands for the cross stitch.
