


All Change

Design Area: 5.57" x 2.71" (78 x 38 stitches)

Backstitch Lines:

———— DMC-310 black ————— DMC-995 electric blue - dk

Beads:

① MHG-2022 Mill Hill Glass Beads-Silver

All change

This small motif is worked on evenweave fabric and is designed show how changing direction is both simple and satisfying. It is not always necessary to add boundary lines but you need to count carefully. Adding or removing lines can change the impact of the design totally.

Materials:

28 count evenweave 5 x 5 inches for each motif or 10 x 7 inches if worked side by side.

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton

310 Black, one skein.

995 Turquoise blue, one skein Any other colour can be used in place of the turquoise.

Mill Hill Glass Seed Beads 2022 Silver (optional)

Tapestry needle No.24

Beading needle

Stitches used:

Back stitch

Long stitch

Method:

Find the centre of the design and work outwards using ONE strand of cotton throughout. Add the beads after the embroidery has been completed using white sewing thread.
