


Try a taste of Sashiko!

Stitches used:

1. Sashiko running stitch
2. Back stitch
3. Back stitch whipped
4. Fly stitch



Fly stitch




Back stitch and back stitch whipped



Easter Sashiko Dove

Trace the pattern onto a 12 inch square of fabric using an HB pencil or water-soluble pen.

Using 3 strands of floss, cotton perle No 5 or sashiko thread and a sashiko or crewel needle (sharp point, big eye), stitch the dove and the Japanese Ganzezashi sashiko pattern in sashiko running stitch. Do not overlap stitches. Stitches are longer than the space between.



Use the drawing of the dove to create a small gift!
